- Children will not be allowed to use entertainment devices, including smart phones, laptops, and electronic tablets, during religious instruction.
- We reserve the right to inspect a person's personal property when there is reasonable belief that the individual is violating the rules or concealing contraband.
- Unauthorized persons will be restricted to designated public spaces during class time, unless given permission by the appropriate staff or volunteer.
- Photos or videos may be taken for the purpose of promoting St. Walter Parish, and Children's Faith Formation.
 Parents who do not wish to have their children's' photos used or videotaped in any promotional material should contact the director and make such a request.
- Health concerns should be brought to the attention of the staff during registration.
